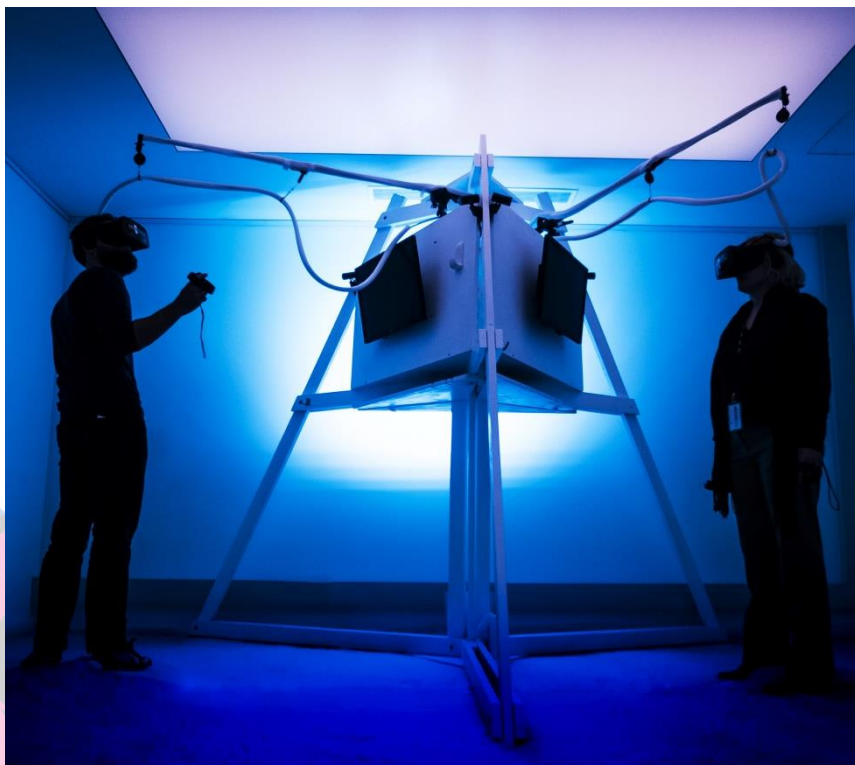

WHAT HAS BEEN DONE

The first part of the work in the LUOVA Project is creating educational content for IO1 and IO2, as well as developing the IO3.

The first Intellectual Output is a compendium of Online Escape Room challenges at beginner, intermediate and advanced levels to develop the key components of creative and critical thinking.

The second Intellectual Output of the project is an in-service training programme to support to front-line youth workers to enable them harness the full potential of these new dynamic learning resources.

The third Intellectual Output is a bespoke, fully mobile, collaborative online learning environment that provides access to all the escape room resources.

2nd TRANSNATIONAL PROJECT MEETING IN POLAND

MEETING IN RZESZÓW, POLAND

Members of the LUOVA PROJECT met for the Second Transnational Partner Meeting on 21st of January 2020 in Rzeszów, Poland



The second project meeting started with a short review of the project – intellectual outputs, objectives, schedule and general development.

The meeting was filled with discussions on the resources developed by the LUOVA partnership in previous months.

Firstly, partners presented a draft framework for development of the online escape room challenges comprising IO1 of the project. Then, the partnership analysed and discussed the value proposition of the IO2 Induction Training Programme for front-line youth workers. Next, partners discussed and agreed the functionality of the e-learning platform.

Additionally, consortium discussed administration, technical and management issues of the project.

The meeting was finished with clear division of tasks among partners and establishing deadlines for coming months.
